

CLUB AND GUEST RULES*

Foothill Farms Cabana Club No.2, Inc.
(Revised September 4, 2007)

INTRODUCTION

The purpose of these rules is as follows: (a) to prevent accidents; (b) to protect the members of Foothill Farms Cabana Club No. 2, Inc. (referred to in these rules as the "club" or "corporation") and their guests; and (c) to make the use of the club more pleasurable for the members.

The club is primarily for the enjoyment of the members. **Guests, though welcome, are limited to 5 guests per visit.** A guest is defined as any person who is not a member (that is, they do not reside in the membership household). Prior approval from the Manager or Board of Directors is required for groups exceeding 5, such as birthday parties, multi-family gatherings, etc.). **Six (6) constitutes a party and the \$25.00 party fee is due in addition to the \$2.00 guest fee for each attendee. This \$25.00 reservation fee is due at the time of your reservation to guarantee your date.** Special rules concerning guests, as well as guests charges are identified in this section of the rules referring to "guests."

ALL PERSONS SHALL USE THE CLUB FACILITIES AT THEIR OWN RISK. The corporation shall have no liability or responsibility for, and no membership, member or guest of a member or any other person shall have a claim against the corporation for personal injury to, or death of, any member or guest or for the loss or damage to the properties of any membership, member or guest. Any loss or damage to any of the properties of the corporation from the acts of conduct of a member or guest of a member, including indebtedness to the corporation, shall be assessed to the offending membership and will be paid as the case of other assessments.

THE CLUB MANAGER AND LIFEGUARDS ARE IN COMPLETE CHARGE OF ALL CLUB FACILITIES and have full authority to take any and all steps necessary to protect the health and safety of all persons using the swimming pool facilities. Any persistent violation of these rules could result in suspension, expulsion or fine as provided for in the bylaws. If the violator is a minor, the parent or guardian shall be notified within twenty-four (24) hours of the discovery of such violation and may be held liable for any damages. **At the manager's or lifeguards' discretion, parents may be required to accompany children due to health, physical disability or discipline reasons.**

CHECK-IN PROCEDURES

1. **SIGN IN.** All persons entering the facility must sign the register located in or near the snack bar before entering the pool area. First and last names of each member and guest must be listed.
2. **MEMBERS MUST REMAIN ON CLUB PROPERTY WITH THEIR GUESTS.**
3. **CHILDREN.** All children under eight (8) years of age must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. All children eight (8) years of age or older must be accompanied by a parent or guardian unless they have demonstrated to the Club Manager or a lifeguard that they are able to swim, non-stop, one length of the pool and tread water for one (1) minute.
4. **BICYCLES, SKATEBOARDS, ROLLERBLADES, ETC.** must be parked in the space provided near the entrance to the pool area. Riding of these items on the grounds is prohibited.
5. **CLUB ATHLETIC EQUIPMENT.** All club athletic equipment must be checked out at the snack bar and a deposit will be required. The deposit will be forfeited if the equipment is not returned or if the equipment is damaged or broken. Any such equipment that is not returned shall be replaced by the responsible member.

PERSONAL SAFETY

1. **PROHIBITED.** The following are not allowed on the property:
 - a. intoxicated persons
 - b. illegal drugs
 - c. pets
 - d. Frisbees
 - e. Hardballs
 - f. Any type of "water guns"
 - g. No scuba diving, that includes any type of scuba gear
2. **RUNNING; HORSEPLAY.** Running, pushing, wrestling, snapping of towels, horseplay and, in the judgement of the lifeguards or Manager, or dangerous practices shall not be allowed.
3. **USE OF BARBECUES.** All barbecuing shall be confined to the designated barbecue areas. The barbecue area must be cleaned after each use by wiping up all spills and grease, wire brushing the grills and replacing the barbecue covers.

POOL SAFETY

1. **GLASS CONTAINERS.** No glass containers shall be taken into the swimming pools or on the pool deck.
2. **ROCK; FOREIGN OBJECTS.** Rocks and other foreign objects shall not be thrown into the swimming pools.
3. **POOL STEPS AND LADDERS.** All pool steps and pool ladders are to be kept clear, especially the ladders in the deep end of the diving pools.
4. **NO TALKING TO LIFEGUARDS.** There shall be no talking to the lifeguards while they are on duty, unless absolutely necessary.
5. **WADING POOL.** The wading pool is to be used **ONLY** by small children who cannot swim.
6. **SLIDE POOL.**
 - a. ***Diving in the slide pool is prohibited*** per a Health Department ruling August 1988.
 - b. ***The shallow end of the slide pool is reserved for beginning swimmers ONLY.*** There shall be no rough play in this area of the slide pool.
 - c. ***The area in front of the slide is to be kept clear of people and floating objects.***
 - d. ***Only one (1) person is allowed on the slide unit at a time. This includes the slide and the slide steps.***
7. **DIVING POOL.**
 - a. **ONLY ONE PERSON IS PERMITTED ON THE DIVING BOARD AT A TIME.**
 - b. Jumping or diving off the SIDES of the diving board and excessive springing on the diving board is prohibited.
 - c. There shall be NO SWIMMING in the area of the diving board while the board is in use.
8. **BACK FLIPS; DANGEROUS ACTS.** Back flips, cartwheels or other dangerous acts shall not be allowed from the edges of the pools.
9. **GUARD TOWER; ROOFS.** Climbing on, jumping on, or diving from the roof or any building or lifeguard tower is prohibited.
10. **PERSONAL SWIMMING EQUIPMENT.** Personal swim items, such as snorkels, softballs, rafts or other large recreational equipment may be used in a pool **ONLY** when that pool is not crowded and only with the approval of the Manager or a lifeguard.
11. **SPITTING.** Spitting in the pools or pool areas is prohibited.
12. **COMMUNICABLE DISEASES.** Persons with colds, running noses, communicable skin diseases or other communicable diseases shall not enter the swimming pools.
13. **DIAPERS.** Infants who are not toilet trained must be diapered before entering the pool.

POOL HAZARDS

In order to maintain pools and pool filters in excellent condition and to reduce maintenance costs, the following rules apply:

1. **CHEWING GUM; HAIR PINS.** Chewing gum and hairpins must be removed prior to entering the pools. Do not throw gum on the pool decks or the grounds, but throw it in containers provided for that purpose. Bandages may be worn in the pools ONLY with the approval of the Manager or lifeguard.
2. **SWIMWEAR.** Persons wearing un-hemmed clothing may not enter the pools.
3. **TRASH, GUM, ETC.** All trash, chewing gum, cigarettes, etc. discarded within the club property must be placed in the containers provided for that purpose.
4. **FOOD OR BEVERAGES.** No food or beverages are permitted in the swimming pools or on the pool decks.

COURTESY

1. **RADIOS, ETC.** All audio equipment must be used with earphones unless the volume is kept very low.
2. **CLUB PROPERTY.** No member, guest or visitor shall take any article belonging to the club from the club premises.
3. **GUARD ROOM, SNACK BAR.** No one except authorized personnel shall be allowed in the lifeguard's room or snack bar.
4. **PUNISHMENT.** No employee, member, guest or visitor shall be in any way punished by any other member, guest or visitor. Parents or guardians must be responsive to and are responsible for the behavior of their children.
5. **EMPLOYEE DISCOURTESY.** Any inattention to duty or lack of courtesy on the part of any club employee shall be reported to the President or appointed member of the Board of Directors and/or the Club Manager.

ADULT SWIM

1. **ADULT SWIM.** Exclusive adult swim time shall be the last fifteen (15) minutes of each hour. During this period, the pools and pool edges shall be cleared of all persons under the age of 18. The Manager shall have the discretion of allowing "all swim" in one or both pools when no adult swimmers are present at opening time.
2. During adult swim period, parents who are in the pool may work on swim techniques with a non-swimmer. *The wading pool is reserved at all times for infants and pre-school children.*
3. Persons 15, 16, and 17 years of age shall be allowed in the pool ONLY TO SWIM LAPS during adult swim time.

GUESTS

1. **DEFINITION.** As mentioned in the introduction to these rules, a "guest" is defined as any person who is not a member (that is, they do not reside in the membership household).
2. **ALL GUESTS ARE ADMITTED ONLY IN THE COMPANY OF A MEMBER AND MEMBERS MUST REMAIN ON CLUB PROPERTY WITH THEIR GUESTS AT ALL TIMES.**
3. **GUEST SWIM CARDS.** Members may purchase guest swim cards from the snack bar attendant or the Membership Chairperson. The cards may be used for any guest, but may not be transferred from one member to another. The cost of the card shall be determined by the Board, and is valid until the number of swims on the card is used up or until the end of the year.

4. **WAIVER OF GUEST FEES.** Guest fees will be waived for the following guests:
 - a. Children under five (5) years of age.
 - b. A baby-sitter of a member's children.

5. **CONDUCT.** Members shall be fully responsible for the conduct of their guests. Guests shall be subject to the same rules as members.

6. **LIMITATIONS.** The following rules apply to guest usage of the club:
 - a. **AT ALL TIMES, GUESTS ARE LIMITED TO 5 GUESTS PER MEMBERSHIP/HOUSEHOLD**
Prior approval from the Manager or the Board of Directors is required for groups exceeding 5 (such as birthday parties, multi-family gathering, etc)
 - b. Each guest will be limited to a total of two (2) visits per week. Visits will be supervised by the Club Manager or any other person designated by the Board.
 - c. Guest may be excluded from entering the pool area or their number limited at certain times to prevent over-crowding of the club facilities.

*These rules may be amended or revised from time to time by the Board of Directors of the Foothill Farms Cabana Club No. 2, Inc. Any such amendment or revision shall be posted on the club bulletin board.

AT THE DISCRETION OF THE MANAGER OR BOARD OF DIRECTORS, THE POOLS MAY BE CLOSED AT ANY TIME DUE MAINTENANCE, SUPER-CHLORINATION, VANDALISM, URGENT REPAIRS OR INCLEMENT WEATHER.
